It is a project which widens the horizons of the standard courses held at the university, in line with the new energies and perspectives of the European Union and in a university which has always been a leading power in the fields of research and services. It is dedicated to those who want to do their best and obtain even more.

Udine is a city about 100 km from Venice, being part of one of the foremost industrial and technological districts in the world. Its location gives one the unique chance to reach three different countries in just 90 minutes – Austria, Slovenia and Croatia.

**THE SCUOLA SUPERIORE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF UDINE.**

The Scuola Superiore is a higher learning institution positioned side by side with the standard courses held at the university. Compared to the university, the courses at the Scuola Superiore are held following an in-depth viewpoint – specific courses, interdisciplinary courses, language courses, laboratory activities and seminars.

The Scuola Superiore offers an intense and qualifying study environment in which one can develop in-depth knowledge at their most, stimulate their personality and creativity, and live in a day-by-day contact together with the academic and research reality. In such a way, it is also a demanding choice; nevertheless, it offers a wide range of services, worthy advantage and a lot of opportunities in order to grow up academically and open up new horizons for one's future.

# RIORRE

Students may have completed their enrollment to any university course. At the Scuola Superiore, they may choose between two classes:

- **Science and Economics Class:** especially meant for those who are enrolled in the faculties of Engineering, Agriculture, Science, Medicine, Economics and Veterinary Medicine.
- **Humanities Class:** especially meant for those who are enrolled in the faculties of Modern Languages, Humanities, Primary Education and Law.

Besides following the lessons of the faculty they are enrolled in, students are supposed to attend the courses and the activities held at the Scuola Superiore, passing the relevant end-of-course tests. Some courses are meant for students of the same faculty, others deal with interdisciplinary subjects of interest and are therefore meant for all faculties.

Students are supposed to follow in-depth English courses in order to improve their language skills; it is also possible to follow courses in other foreign languages.

At the end of their studies (Master's Degree), students at the Scuola Superiore obtain a special certificate named Diploma.

## **A FULL IMMERSION INTO KNOWLEDGE.**

To keep their scholarship at the Scuola Superiore, students are obliged to:

- attend university lessons as for their study plan together with the courses and the activities at the Scuola Superiore;
  - keep an appropriate average, i.e. not below 27/30 as a comprehensive average and not below 24/30 for each exam;
  - keep up with the study plan and do each exam within the required time;
  - pass the final exam (oral assessment with research paper) at the Scuola Superiore in October of each year.
- Developing a strong sense of community is essential to benefit from the advantage offered by this institution. Thus, students are supposed to live in the premises of the Scuola Superiore from Monday to Friday during the whole academic period.

# UNIUD

Privileged study conditions are a key-factor assured to students at the Scuola Superiore besides an in-depth, high-quality preparation:

- free board and lodging
- exemption from tuition fees (except for the first installment)
- special agreements with departments, laboratories, libraries and interdepartmental centres in order to encourage research activity in the University of Udine already from the beginning of the studies

Students are provided with a tutoring service assisting them as far as academic issues – study career, relationships with teachers and exams organisation – are concerned.

The Scuola Superiore also collaborates with the French Grandes Ecoles, the International Centre for Mechanical Sciences in Udine and the school of advanced studies Scuola Normale in Pisa, Tuscany.

## HOW TO ENROL.

In order to become a student of the Scuola Superiore, an necessary admission examination has to be passed. Information about the enrolment and the number of places available is stated in the relevant call for applications. This is published each year by the month of May and remains available at the Scuola Superiore, the Orientation and Tutoring Centre, the Student Secretary's Office of the university and on the website [www.scuolaisuperiore.uniud.it](http://www.scuolaisuperiore.uniud.it)

### Compulsory requirements

Only those complying with the age limit specified in the call for applications and who have not yet attended a university course are eligible for admission. A study certificate is also required in order to enrol at the university. The final mark on the certificate will not influence the result of the admission examination. In order to participate in the admission examination, an application must be submitted in line with the requirements on the call for application.

### Admission examination

There are two types of examinations, one for each class – Science and Economics and Humanities – which aim to assessing the preparation, the skills and the motivation necessary to the applicant in order to receive an excellence education. For both classes, the examination consists in:

- a) a written part made up of two subjects among those specified on the call for applications;
- b) an oral assessment on two subjects chosen by the applicant among those specified on the call for applications.

All necessary programmes to prepare the examination, as well as some mock tests for the written part, can be found on the Scuola Superiore website. The Scuola Superiore does not replace the university, so it is necessary for the selected applicants to enrol at one of the courses held at the University of Udine.
